

# Fr. Joe's Jottings

During this Mass, the students of Sacred Heart Parish will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and are invited to the social. This is a great example of parishes within a pastorate working together. The reality is that those two local school districts collaborate so well in many activities already, therefore we can build upon some existing relationships.

At 1:30 pm on June 9th, Bishop DeGrood will celebrate Mass with the people of SS Peter and Paul and be confirming the candidates from that parish. There will not be a social afterwards because as a pastorate, all will be preparing for the annual fishing charity event for the funding of seminarian education. SS Peter and Paul Parish and St. John the Evangelist, Ft. Pierre will be welcoming the seminarians from both the Diocese of Sioux Falls and the Diocese of Rapid City to evening prayer and social. This would be an example of parishes and dioceses working together.






