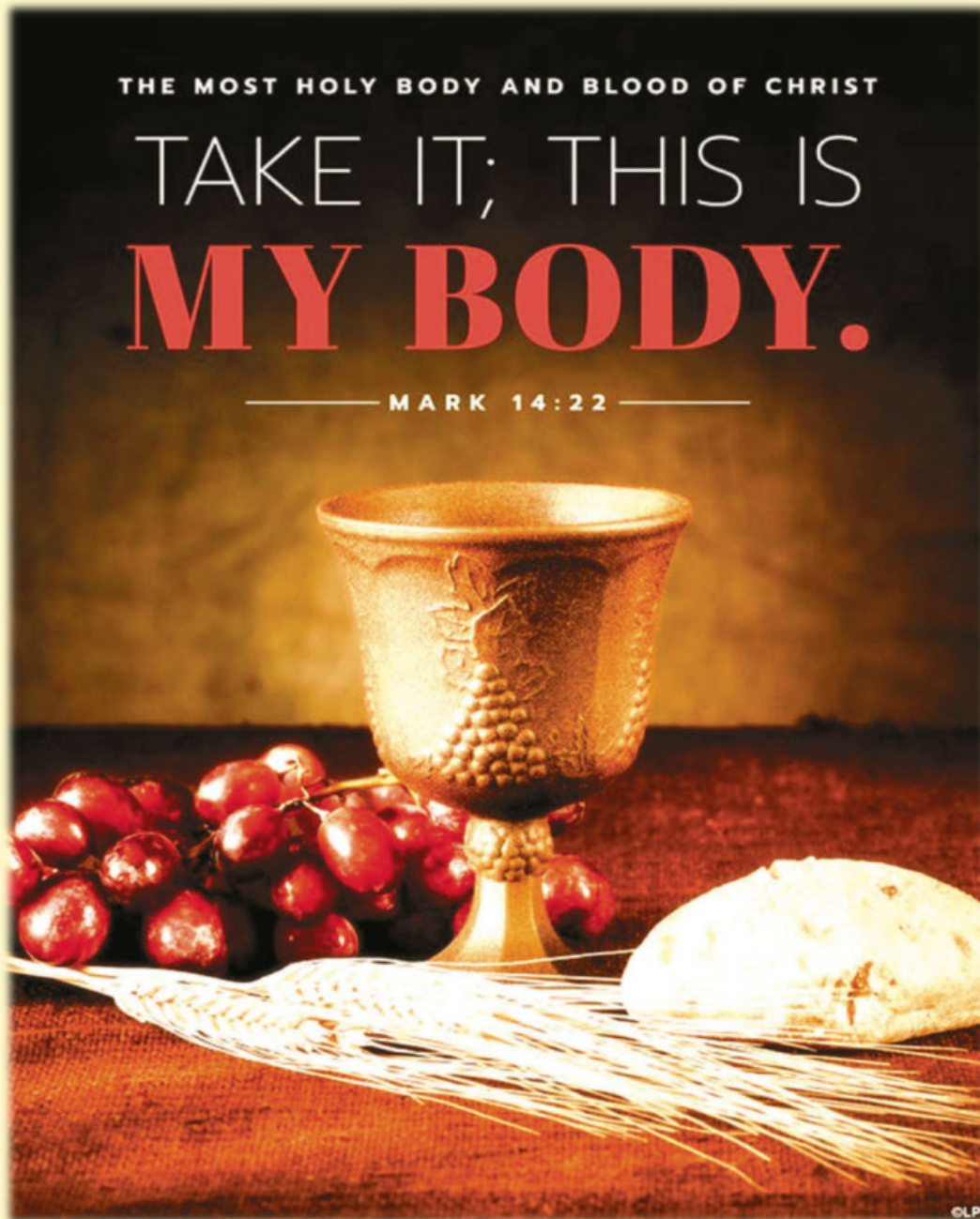

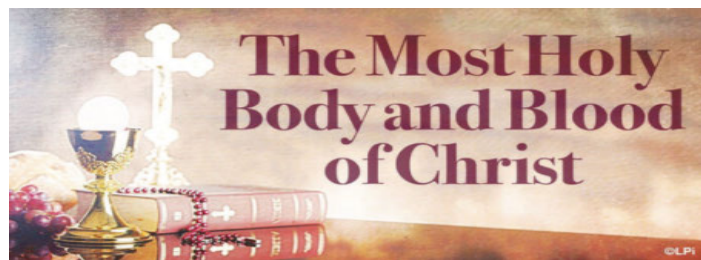


Fr. Joe's Jottings

Although school is on out for summer, taking time to read is still important. Here are some fun ways to encourage reading and check for comprehension.

One way would be to create an animated timeline of the book. Illustrate 10 scenes in chronological order from the novel. Each scene needs to have a picture that either symbolizes or demonstrates what has happened during the part and a caption. The caption describes in sentence form what is happening in that scene.

Another idea would be to create a book jacket of the novel being read. On the front cover, draw and color an illustration for the book. On the inside front flap, write descriptions of the main characters. On the inside back flap, write a description of the setting and a short summary of the book. Finally on the back cover, write quotes from the book that are important to understanding the story.

A third idea would be to create a book report quiz. Create a 10 question quiz for their book. The questions could be multiple choice, true or false, matching, or fill in the blank. An answer key would need to be made.

The fourth way would be to illustrate story elements on a plain t-shirt. The front of the shirt could be a replica of the book cover OR what the child feels should represent the book cover. Include title and author. On the right sleeve, color the main and supporting characters. On the left sleeve, color a representation of the setting and problem. On the back, the child can color their favorite scene in the book.

Those are not the only ways. There are many creative ideas out there. As long as the child is having fun, it is a win!
