

Fr. Simon Sez

A young man without faith, religion, or spirituality in one of my former parishes asked me, "Why do Catholics call you father?" He was civilly married to a Catholic young lady. They were not married in the Church and had two little daughters who were not baptized. I told him, "Because your daughters have bodies and souls, they need a biological father and a spiritual father. You are their biological father. I need to be their spiritual father."

This Father's Day we honor our fathers, living and deceased. More importantly, we honor God our Father who gave us life through our earthly fathers and may have been able to give us a glimpse of eternal life through them. God the Father is the one who created us and sent his Son to redeem us through whom we receive the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of biological life and eternal life. God the Father does this out of love for us. He created us in his image and likeness and redeemed us by making us his sons and daughters by grafting us onto the vine, the Mystical Body of Christ, the Church with the Son of God, Jesus Christ as the Head. By our created nature, we are, and will always be, in the image and likeness of God our Father and, by our baptized nature, we will always belong to Christ our Lord and Savior. There is nothing we can do to change these realities.

The problem is, of course, sin. We can choose to deny God by rejecting him with one unrepented mortal sin, but he cannot deny himself (See 2 Timothy 2:13). Because of the effects of original sin and God's mercy, he wants us to return to him like the prodigal son, forgive us of sin, and put on a divine homecoming feast in heaven for us for all eternity.

Also, by God's design, we can come to realize this love of God the Father for us through our earthly fathers. This should happen but is never sufficient. The good news, according to Neal Lozano, is that we can catch up. His main objective was to write a book on God the Father to help people come to this realization and exceed it. Before he could write this book, Abba's Heart: Finding Our Way Back to the Father's Delight, which he eventually did, he knew he had to write a book on deliverance to prepare people for this book. His first book, Unbound: A Practical Guide to Deliverance, became a national bestseller. I was trained in his method of deliverance ministry. These books with ministry and study guides can be found at store.heartofthefather.com.

After being able to experience some freedom in Christ, we are open to receive God the Father's blessing and affirmation of our identity, purpose and destiny. We are then ready to realize one of the promises of our daily prayer taught to us by Jesus Christ himself: "Our Father...Give us this day, our daily bread."

Thanks be to God, I had the honor of baptizing those two daughters of that biological father, because he was willing to let me be his daughters' spiritual father.
