The palms that are handed out for Palm Sunday are burned into ash. The ashes are then used the following year for Ash Wednesday.

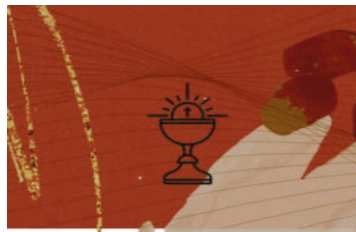

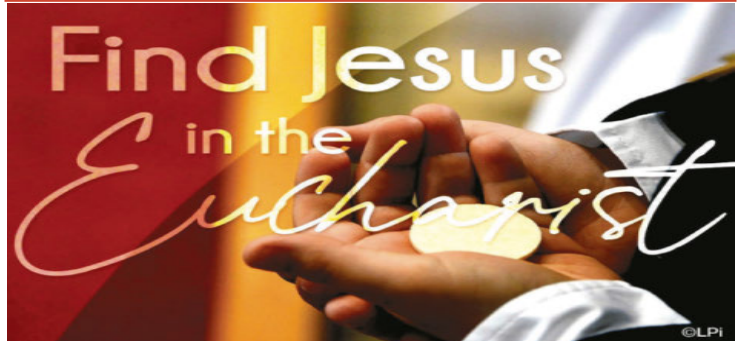
