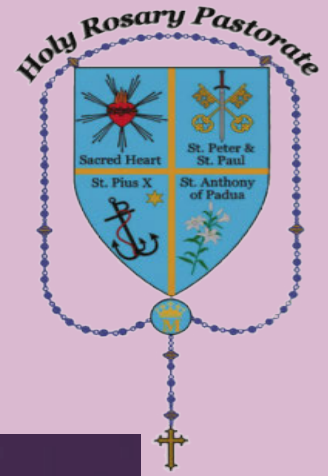

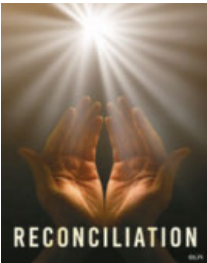

Y stands for yourself. After Jesus and others, it is important to take care of yourself. God created you as a unique and beautiful soul, that He loves dearly.

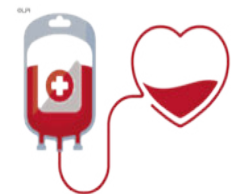
If we follow this acronym of JOY, we will find ourselves asking if our actions are something that Jesus would want, if the action is helpful to others, and if it will bring You closer to God.

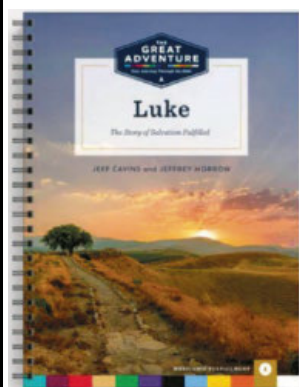
